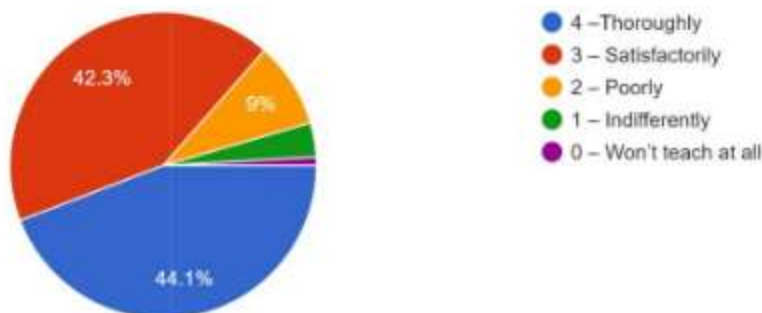

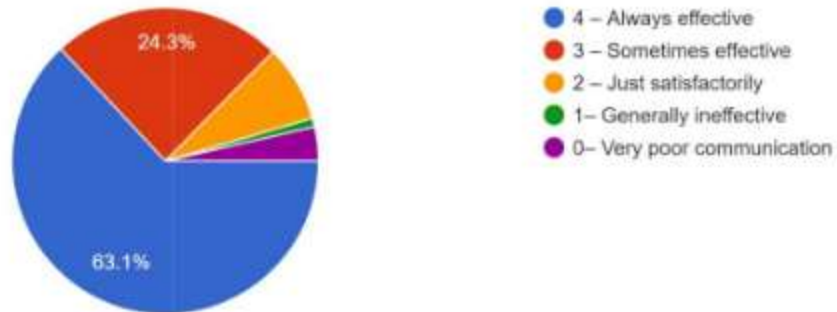

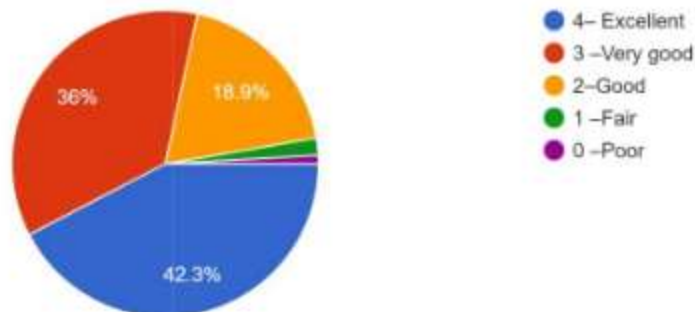

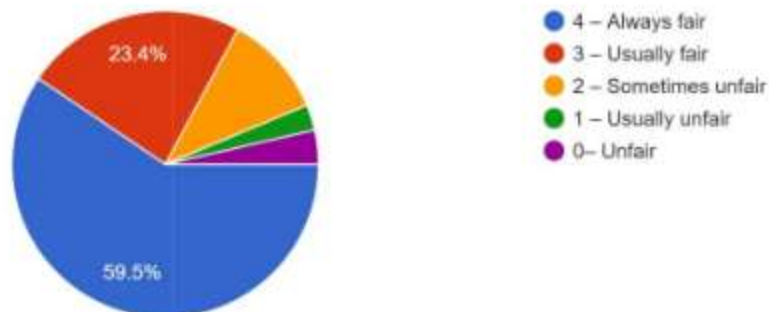

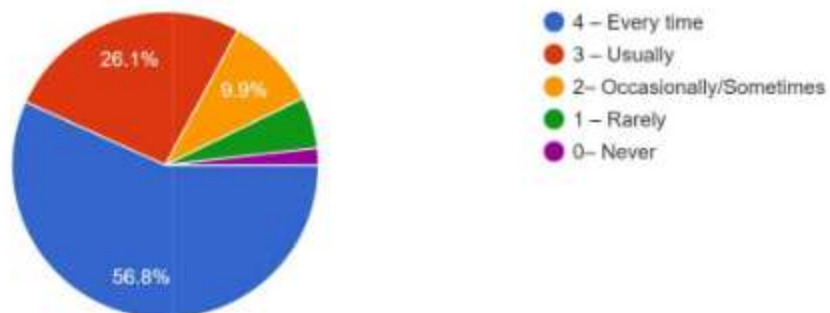

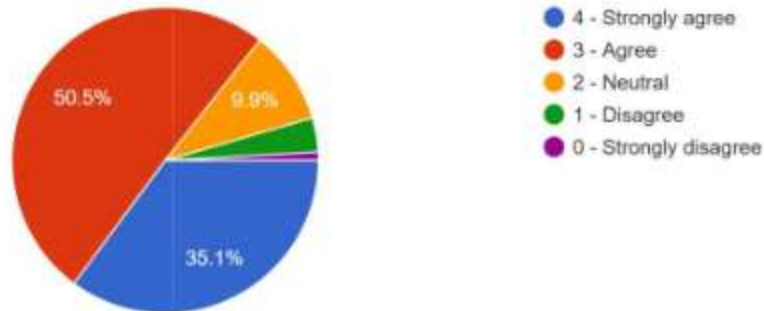

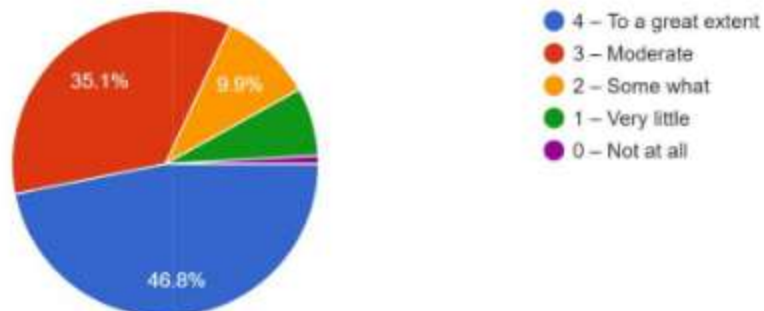

• Key findings from the survey-

1. A high percentage of students (95.5%) complete satisfaction over the quality of Teaching Learning in our college.

2. Students have expressed overall satisfaction regarding the syllabus completion (95.5%), preparedness of the teachers (95.4%) and communications with the students (87.4%).

3. Students have appreciated the teacher's attitude towards teaching and fairness in evaluation.
4. The students have expressed satisfaction regarding the mentorship programme, skill development programme run by the college.
5. The college provides ample opportunities for cultural activities, sports activities and extracurricular activities. The students have opined that college also provides good environment for emotional growth of students.
